Essay Guide for TCU/IAM Advanced Training

Dear TCU/IAM ADVANCED TRAINING CANDIDATE,

I am delighted that you are interested in the TCU/IAM Advanced Training Program. Please provide a brief essay answering the following questions as part of our admission requirements into the TCU/IAM Advanced Training Program.

1. **Why are you interested in TCU/IAM?** (What is your career goal and how do you see TCU/IAM helping you with your career goals?)
2. **In what area of the transportation industry would you like to establish your career?**
For example: Airline, Railroad (Passenger/Freight), Bargeline companies, Options open
3. **Much of TCU/IAM's training is classroom work using computers. Are you okay with this type of training?**
4. **How would you evaluate your performance on your Center?**
5. **Do you have any certifications?**
6. **Do you have any work experience?**
